COURT CALENDARS NOW AVAILABLE ON COURT WEBSITE

Santa Ana - The public can now obtain calendars for general jurisdiction (civil actions more than \$25,000) civil, family law, and probate court, in as much as two weeks advance of their hearing date, by accessing the information on the Orange County Superior Court's web site, announced Chief Executive Officer Alan Slater.

"This is a perfect example of how the court is using technology to make it more convenient for the public and lawyers to access court information. In the near future, the public also will be able to pay for traffic tickets online using a credit card and enroll for traffic school," said Alan Slater.

To access the court calendars online go to the court website at www.oc.ca.gov/superior and click on "Civil/Criminal Traffic" and click again on "Civil Calendars." For family law and probate court calendars, click on "Family/Juvenile/Probate" and click on the appropriate calendar. If you do not have the case name or number, you can simply scroll through the calendars to find your case. The public can also access Probate Attorney Notes online to find the status of a case by entering the case number or the decedent's last name in the search menu.

The online calendars are provided only as a convenience for court users and usually will be updated at the close of each business day. Please check the information at the top right corner of the calendar to make sure that the information is current. The court cannot assume liability for changes in court calendars. If there is any doubt as to a court date, please call the court.
