**Event:** **Opening of Children's Chambers Kicks Off Law Day  
"Protecting the Best Interests of Our Children"**

The Orange County Superior Court will celebrate Law Day 2001 with the opening of the Children's Chamber facility at its Central Justice Center. The new 400 sq. ft. facility provides a safe supervised environment for children 2½ to 17 years old while their parents are at court hearings. The facility will be staffed by the Community Service Programs (CSP), Victim Assistance Program and can accommodate a limited number of children throughout the day. This service will save those who use the courts the cost of child care while at court proceedings.

This year's Law Day theme, "Protecting the Best Interests of Our Children," marks the first time in the 23 year history of this event that an emphasis has been placed on the role of the law, lawyers and the courts in addressing the needs of children and their families.
