Swearing-In Ceremony Scheduled for 5 Newly Elected Judges

Santa Ana - Presiding Judge of the Orange County Superior Court, Frederick P. Horn will administer the oath of office to five newly elected Orange County judges Monday, January 6, 2003 at 8:30 am. The informal ceremony will be held in Department C1 at the Central Justice Center, 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana.

The newly elected judges are Lance P. Jensen, Kimberly Menninger, Johns S. Adams, Kelly MacEachern and Glenda Sanders.

Lance P. Jensen, 42, was elected to Judicial Office No. 8 on March 5, 2002. He is a former Orange County Deputy District Attorney. Mr. Jensen is a graduate of the University of Southern California and received his juris doctorate degree from Western State University School of Law.

Kimberly Menninger, 43, was elected to Judicial Office No. 3 on March 5, 2002. She is a former Orange County Deputy District Attorney. Ms. Menninger is a graduate of Saddleback Community College, UCLA, and received her juris doctorate degree from Loyola Law School.

John S. Adams, 50, was elected to Judicial Office No. 21 on November 5, 2002. He was a business attorney in private practice and served as a judge, pro tem. Mr. Adams is a graduate from Macalester College in St. Paul, Minnesota, and received his juris doctorate degree from Stanford Law School.

Kelly MacEachern, 48, was elected to Judicial Office No. 22 on November 5, 2002. She is a former Orange County Deputy District Attorney. Ms. Mc Eachern is a graduate of UCLA and received her juris doctorate degree from Southwestern University Law School.

Glenda Sanders, 46, was elected to Judicial Office No. 27 on November 5, 2002. She was a civil and criminal trial attorney for more than 20 years and also taught as an adjunct professor at Chapman University School of Law. Ms. Sanders is a graduate of Natal University, South Africa, where she graduated first in her law school class, and then obtained a master's degree in law from Cambridge University, England.
