Temporary Judge Applications Are Now Available Online

Santa Ana – The Orange County Superior Court is pleased to announce the opening of the recruitment and application process for Temporary Judges. If you are an attorney who is interested in becoming a Temporary Judge, please read the **Application Letter** and complete the **Temporary Judge Application**. The Application Letter describes the minimum qualifications and selection criteria which will be used in the application process.

Attorneys who are not currently active with the Court's Temporary Judge Program and would like to be considered must complete the application process. Attorneys who are currently active participants in the Temporary Judge program have been sent a renewal application.

Applications must be received by December 31, 2015. Late applications will not be accepted. The Court will invite the attorneys who successfully pass the application process to attend two mandatory three-hour training sessions in late spring/early summer 2016.
