6 **TITLE: Procedure for Disclosure of Evidence Audit Records**

8 This Order establishes the procedure for the disclosure of evidence audit records in a
9 juvenile proceeding, incorporating by reference Administrative Order No 20/24, issued by
10 Presiding Judge Kirk H. Nakamura on October 15, 2020. (Attachment A.)

12 The Juvenile Court further incorporates by reference the Stipulation and Order
13 Regarding Disclosure of Evidence Audit Records, Remedy Record Printouts and Associated
14 Reports, attached to Administrative Order No. 20/24 and entered into by the Orange County
15 Sheriff's Department, by and through its attorneys, the Orange County Counsel's Office, the
16 Orange County District Attorney, and the Orange County Public Defender regarding
17 disclosure of documents pertaining to the Orange County Sheriff's Department "Evidence
18 Audit" records, Remedy system printouts, and Orange County Sheriff's Department reports
19 ("DRs") associated with entries in the Evidence Audit Records ("the Stipulation" or "the Global
20 Stipulation"), subject to the conditions and modifications noted in this Order. The process
21 described in the Stipulation is equally available to other defense counsel upon agreement to
22 be bound by the terms of the applicable protective order as set forth by the Stipulation.

24 For purposes of this Order: (1) Any reference in Administrative Order No. 20/24 or the
25 Global Stipulation to "criminal proceedings" shall be understood to mean juvenile court
26 proceedings; and (2) Any reference in Administrative Order No. 20/24 or the Global Stipulation

1 to "defendant" shall be understood to mean a juvenile justice involved youth. A copy of the
2 Stipulation and Administrative Order No. 20/24 is attached to this Order as Attachment A.


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4 Any evidence audit records disclosed in relation to a juvenile proceeding may contain
5 confidential information subject to the protections of Welfare and Institution Code section 827.
6 If there is information found within the records that is protected confidential information, the
7 attorney of record for the youth shall not share or disseminate the protected information
8 except to entitled parties as enumerated under Welfare and Institutions Code section 827.

9
10 This Order does not prevent any party from seeking records otherwise permitted by
11 law.

13 This Order may be considered a "standing order" and is applicable to all juvenile
14 proceedings in the Orange County Superior Court. This Order is effective immediately and
15 shall remain in effect until modified by further Order of the Court.
