REPORTS FROM STANDING COMMITTEES & WORKING GROUPS

- A. Education** - Commissioner Vachet provided a brief update. A follow up meeting with Vern Burton is scheduled for April 25, 2023. Commissioner Vachet and EEA will meet to discuss the details for the upcoming essay contest in October.
