



Keeping Kids Safe Program for Supervised Visitation Services

The Keeping Kids Safe Program serves as a resource for the community and for Family Court by providing information and reference material on supervised visitation services in Orange County. The program, provided by Family Court Services in collaboration with two participating non-profit agencies, offers low cost, safe, and professional services for monitored visitation, safe exchanges, and therapeutic visitation in a child centered environment in 6 different on-site locations within Orange County. Parents may qualify for reduced hourly rates through the ACCESS to Visitation grant for non-residential parents, administered by the California Administrative Office of the Courts. All fees, determined by the non-profit agency, are based upon a sliding scale depending on the client's income.

Services are conducted by professionally trained staff and volunteers who are in compliance with the Uniform Standard of Practice of Professional Providers of Supervised Visitation as set forth in the California Rules of Court, Standards of Judicial Administration, Section 5.20.
