Findings and Orders – Prejudgment

- The court finds, by a preponderance of the evidence presented, a violation of Penal Code section 745(a):

Findings and Orders – Postjudgment

- The Court finds that the true finding was sought, obtained, or imposed in violation of Penal Code section 745(a). The Court vacates the true finding and disposition. The Court finds the true finding and disposition legally invalid pursuant to Penal Code section 745(e)(2)(A), and orders new proceedings.
- The Court finds that the disposition is in violation of Penal Code section 745(a) and is legally invalid and imposes a new disposition pursuant to Penal Code section 745(e)(2)(B).

7. The Court finds the charges and/or true finding are based only on a violation of paragraph 3 of Penal Code section 745(a), which may be rectified by modifying the disposition. The Court therefore vacates the true finding and disposition pursuant to Penal Code section 745(e)(2)(A), finds that the true finding is legally invalid, and modifies the disposition as follows to impose an appropriate remedy for the violation that occurred pursuant to Penal Code section 745(e)(2)(A):

8. The Court finds by a preponderance of the evidence presented, pursuant to Penal Code section 1473.7(a)(3), grounds exist for relief and vacates the true finding and/or disposition pursuant to Penal Code section 1473.7(e)(1).
