Court Inaugurates Online Traffic Tickets Payments

The Orange County Superior Court launched a new traffic infraction payment plan, as part of a Court User Portal initiative that will enhance public access to court services.

“Our court is investing heavily in new technologies, aiming to provide the highest quality and accessible justice to all,” said Kirk Nakamura, Orange County Superior Court Presiding Judge.

Court customers can access the new site from the [Court Home Page](#) by clicking [Online Payment Plan](#) and enter their citation number or OC Pay number.

“Increasing convenient access to court users continues to be a priority for our Court,” Orange County Superior Court Executive Officer David Yamasaki said. “These improvements are a testimony to the very skilled members of our staff in the development of these features as well as the continued commitment of the Judicial Council in supporting innovations toward improved service delivery.”

If the citation is eligible, payment options will be displayed for selection by the customer. Once a payment plan is selected, the customer will be able to enter a phone number for automated reminders, make their initial payment, and print the payment agreement.

This new service to the public became possible via a [Court Innovations Grant Program](#) of the Judicial Council of California. The Online Payment Plan is one of a series of services that will be included in the Court User Portal aiming to improve public access to court services.
