

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**TITLE: RELEASING THE NAME, DATE OF BIRTH AND DATE OF
DEATH OF A MINOR FOSTER CHILD**

TO: DIRECTOR, ORANGE COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY

Government Code Section 6252.6 states that "[n]otwithstanding paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) of Section 827 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, after the death of a foster child who is a minor, the name, date of birth and date of death of the child shall be subject to disclosure by the county child welfare agency pursuant to this chapter." The section does not address other sections governing confidentiality of this information, such as Welfare and Institutions Code Section 10850, and thus this Court has been in the practice of requiring requesting entities and persons to file Section 827 petitions to obtain that information. To clarify this Court's interpretation of the law, which remedies any perceived conflicts in the law, the Court issues this miscellaneous order.
